FLAME will continue publishing outspoken position papers in mainstream and college media exposing corrupt <u>UN actions defaming Israel</u> and <u>attempting to</u> <u>rob</u> the Jewish state of rights to its ancient homeland.

• The Biden administration has made clear its intention to attempt to invite nuclear-weapons-seeking Iran back <u>without preconditions</u> into the disastrous 2015 "Iran Deal" that paved the way for Iranian nuclear bombs—which the U.S. wisely exited just three years ago.
