Why Beeper Attacks Won't Suffice: Israel Must Fully Defeat Its Enemies

Dear Friend of Israel, Friend of FLAME:

For the last 30 years, Israel has compromised with its enemies, given up territory, accepted ceasefires, and contented itself with limited military operations following countless enemy attacks. This strategy has clearly failed, as Israel's neighbors have continued ceaseless violence against its citizens for decades.

The most epic disaster, of course, was Hamas's October 7th massacre, which exploded into a continuous war on two fronts—against Hamas in the south and Hezbollah in the north. Over the past year, nearly a thousand Israelis have been killed and more than a hundred thousand have been displaced from their homes—robbing Israel's sovereignty over more than 10% of its territory.

Israel's government and the overwhelming majority of its citizens agree that Israel needs a new strategy—one that ensures Israel's survival and the safety of its citizens for decades to come. While last week's beeper and walkie-talkie attacks were a brilliant tactical success, they are insufficient. Victory means eliminating Hamas as a viable force in Gaza and decisive disabling of Hezbollah in Lebanon.

Unfortunately, the Biden-Harris White House does not share this strategy for Israel's survival. While both Biden and Harris claim to support "Israel's right to defend itself," this turns out to be mere "weasel wording," since both refuse to say they support Hamas's demise or harsh responses to Hezbollah. Indeed, Kamala Harris cannot mention the Gaza war without demanding a ceasefire—which is the opposite of Israel's primary goal in the conflict and thus undermines Israel's existential interests.

Stop Terrorism on Campus

Attacks on Israel and Jews on scores of American universities have exploded into a jihadi-fueled, violent revolution against American freedoms and values

While protesters resist about rules, state and federal laws... writing and destroying campus property, refusing access to Jewish students and physically attacking those who disagree with their terrorist ideology—giving college administrators little room to stop the insanity.

What are the facts?

Anti-American and anti-Israeli college campuses have skyrocketed by 70% since Hamas's October 7 massacre in Israel—and they've become more violent. Jewish students have been harassed, harmed from afar, and physically attacked by pro-Hamas demonstrators, reminiscent of Nazi behavior in 1930s Germany. Scandinavian white schools (often) have speech against Black, Muslim and LGBTQ+ students, they refuse to protect Jewish and pro-Israel students.

Majority campus administrators—and faculty—have become so emboldened, they no longer hide their support for the Global War on Terror. They've been seen waving down American flags and replacing them with those of anti-American "Palestine." Books they reject such as *Liberalism as Freedom of speech, routinely seize and destroy school property and deny students free institutions have opened the door to anti-Semitism.*

Anti-American and genocidal goals inspired by Islamist terror: No wonder pro-Hamas protesters parade the black banner of jihadic oppression, from "Death to America! Death to Israel!" No surprise, either, that campus protesters cheered such massive trouble and drove attacks on Israel recently. Their stated goal is to "globalize the intifada." Millions support the pro-Hamas mission to create an Islamist caliphate, as well as the terrorist group's slaughter of some 1,200 innocent Israeli, Jewish, the media showed "From the river to the sea, Palestine will be free," a demand the U.S. House of Representatives recently declared to be antisemitic—and the genocide of seven million Israeli Jews.

A revolution of hate that opposes civil liberties and academic freedom: This violent revolutionary movement is rooted in neo-Marxism, which divides the world into oppressor and oppressed. The ideology, which undermines American university culture, has inspired both critical race theory (CRT) and Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) policies. It classifies people, organizations and nations into a hierarchy of good and evil according to their allegiance to the oppressed-oppressed axis. Oppressors are defined to defeat "as any means necessary"—a slogan seen at many anti-Israel protests. Campus revolutionaries and their faculty mentors consider Jews, Israel and the U.S. to be "white" oppressors and therefore subject to violent "resistance"—such as breaking into and setting buildings, attacking Jewish students, and preventing " Zionist" students' access to their own campus.

College administrators have scandalously failed to do

their jobs: Their two foremost responsibilities are to protect students' safety and academic freedom. That means no tolerance for harassment or intimidation of Jewish or any students. It means honoring the search for truth and free expression—and forbidding "cancel culture." Finally, administrators must apply policies fairly. If they speak or call the genocide against any ethnic group on campus is not permitted, college administrators cannot allow administrators to call for Israeli destruction.

Four ways Americans can shut down terror on campus: If college administrators who fail to speak routinely and fairly speech—and fail to protect students' freedom—should be removed. Students who violate school policies on hate speech, harassment, flag desecration, or trespassing should be suspended or expelled. Faculty who do the same—often those with tenure—should be fired for cause.

Their behavior is hateful, harmful and often unlawful

If Congress must increase penalties related to antisemitic and unlawful behavior on campus, on schools and retention of visas for foreign students who participate in antisemitic or unlawful activities.

All colleges should face legal consequences for failing to stamp out antisemitism. Already Columbia University faces a lawsuit that alleges "wreck-the-school" harassment of Jewish students, who have been punched, shoved, spat on, blocked from attending classes and moving freely about campus. Dozens of other U.S. colleges face similar federal lawsuits.

If **Doves** should withhold gifts from colleges that refuse to act against antisemitism. Many donors have already canceled their giving, including Robert Kraft, CEO of the New England Patriots, who pulled his support from Columbia University due to unacknowledged Jew-hatred.

The current behavior of "pro-Palestinian" activists at American colleges and universities is hateful, harmful and too often unlawful—on campuses. If **Force** outrage suffered by Jewish college students were directed against any other ethnic or "oppressed" group on campus, it would not be tolerated for a minute, let alone, most months and years. **Time to shut down the intifada.**

The reasons for Team Biden-Harris's conditional support of Israel stems from the fact that they and their national security advisors believe it's possible to reform and make peace with Iran, the world's leading organizer of [global jihad](#), and its Islamist proxies, Hamas, Hezbollah, and Yemen's Houthis.

The White House holds this position despite all evidence of its failure since the beginning of their administration—starting with Iran's dramatic increase in wealth and its progress toward threshold production of nuclear weapons. Accordingly, Iran has funded Hamas's and Hezbollah's launch of a [massive war](#) against Israel, as well as the Houthis blockading of the Red Sea, effectively paralyzing global shipping.

Following its bankrupt strategy, the U.S. has done nothing to halt these terrorist aggressions except half-hearted defensive actions and [futile attempts at appeasement](#).

The tragedy of this situation is that Israel's strategy directly, forcefully and effectively serves the interests of the United States to thwart the spread of terrorism and Iran's hegemony in the Middle East. Unfortunately, the U.S. administration believes falsely that those fanatically committed to Islamic conquest can be derailed by financial rewards, paltry land swaps or global respect. The only solution for Israel—and for the United States—is victory over the terrorists, starting with Israel's defeat of Hamas and Hezbollah . . . preferably with [whole-hearted U.S. support](#).

Most Israelis reject making concessions to their enemies and support a new strategy. A recent poll by the Jewish News Syndicate (JNS), for example, found that nearly three quarters of Israelis reject Hamas's demands for a ceasefire. Furthermore, 61% of Israelis agreed with the sentence, "[Only military pressure](#) on Hamas leader Yahya Sinwar and planned military actions including hostage rescue operations can lead to the release of the hostages."

Many Israelis also want their government to take a tougher stance on Hezbollah. According to a poll by the Israel Democracy Institute, about two thirds of Israelis want their government to respond to the Iranian proxy's attacks more aggressively, with 42% saying the IDF should "launch an assault deep into Lebanon that includes striking at its infrastructure." In addition, 52% of Israelis polled by JNS believe that if the U.S. asks Israel not to attack Hezbollah or Iran, Israel should [defy the Americans](#) and act in accordance with its own interests.

Tragically, Biden and company make every effort to ensure Israel never defeats its enemies. Although Mr. Biden initially approved Israel's "elimination" of Hamas, it didn't take long for his administration to reverse course. They've hammered Israel to accept a ceasefire that would leave Hamas in control of Gaza, allow the terrorists to rearm, and permit them to conduct another atrocity reminiscent of October 7th—all in the service of "de-escalating the conflict." The irony is painfully thick on this point, since it is Hezbollah that started the war with Israel last October and "escalates" it with daily attacks on the Jewish state. Perhaps the U.S. should [try pressuring Hezbollah](#), whose Lebanese government receives half a billion dollars a year in American aid.

Team Biden-Harris naively believe that peace can be made with Iran and its proxies. That's why, upon taking office, President Biden immediately tried to restore the hapless Nuclear Deal, which gave Iran an unimpeded path to develop nuclear weapons. Biden has also given Iran billions of dollars in sanctions relief—including \$6 billion in 2023, in exchange for freeing five American hostages, and another \$10 billion earlier this year. Instead of cooperating with the U.S., Iran used this money to fund terrorist proxies and [accelerate its nuclear program](#).

The U.S. helps strengthen Iran, Hezbollah, the Houthis and even Hamas. Iran now has enough material to produce five nuclear bombs within a week. The Houthis, whom Biden *delisted* as a designated global terrorist organization, are now attacking international shipping on a daily basis. Hezbollah, despite Israel's beeper attack, continues to shoot its missiles at Israeli citizens. Even Hamas, thanks to constant U.S. restraint of Israel, retains realistic hope it will [survive to murder again](#).

Middle East peace can only be achieved through decisive victory over Israel's—and America's—enemies. This means no more talk of ceasefires. No more withholding weapons or moral support from Israel. Finally, no more [obstructing Israel's efforts](#) to defeat the enemies who fight fulltime to annihilate it.

Please make the point when speaking with family, friends, colleagues—or in letters to the editor—that appeasing terrorists and their sponsors does not bring peace. It only breeds more bloodshed and more terrorism. Only through strength will Israel defeat our mutual enemies in the Middle East—and only with [determined support](#) of the United States.
